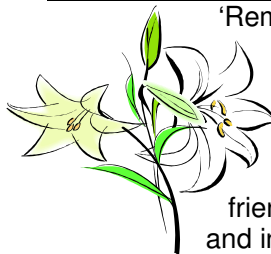
Children's Society Boxes
